	I agree to notify any and all persons involved in the project of the requirements of the Construction & Demolition Waste Management Plan.
	I understand that I am responsible for obtaining copies of any and all weight tickets from all haulers and all facilities which receive debris from this project.
	I understand that once the project is complete, a Final Compliance Report with weight tickets from receiving facilities must be filed. If I fail to file a Final Compliance Report verifying that the minimum recycling requirements for the project were met, my entire performance security deposit will be forfeited. No refund shall be authorized when the submittal date of the completed final report is beyond 180 days from the date a covered project has been completed.
	I understand that it is my responsibility to inform the haulers of my recycling plan, and my chosen recycling facility.
